High Impact Neighborhood Lead Grant.

Client Application Intake and Enrollment – we will be receiving and processing lead applications and determining eligibility for 495 units requiring lead abatement. These services are directed specifically to 4 census tracts in the Glenville Community. Due to the targeted nature of the High Impact Neighborhood Grant, this location will provide accessibility to the applicants and a face of the program in the community. The location will house an Intake Specialists for application intake, 2 Inspectors to do Lead Inspection Risk Assessments, and a Program Manager for the 2019 High Impact Neighborhood Lead grant.
