Purpose:

This Department requests legislation to grant consent to the County to construct the improvement on Green Road from Euclid Avenue to South Corporation Line/City of Euclid and to authorize the Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Project to enter into one or more agreements with

the County to make the improvement.

Description:

The County will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and contribute 60% of the design and 80% of eligible construction costs. The improvements include asphalt milling, pavement base repair, asphalt resurfacing and installation of ADA compliant ramps, approximately 1.13 miles. This project was selected based on its poor pavement condition rating to be part of the County Annual Resurfacing Program in 2022. The program's goal is to improve pavement condition on the County Road system.
