Ordinance No. 864-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into an amendment to Contract No. CT 7013 PS 2020-60 with GT Environmental, Inc. to implement and stabilize accepted recommendations needed to improve efficiency, consistency, and reliable service delivery for residential solid waste and recycling services, for a period not to exceed two years.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 1374-2019, passed November 25, 2019, and Board of Control Resolution No. 45-20, adopted January 20, 2020, the Council authorized Contract No. CT 7013 PS 2020-60 with GT Environmental, Inc. to assess and develop a strategic approach to improve efficiency, consistency, and reliable service delivery for residential solid waste and recycling services; and

WHEREAS, additional services are necessary to implement and stabilize the accepted recommendations for an additional two-year period; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. CT 7013 PS 2020-60 with GT Environmental, Inc. to add the additional services of implementation and stabilization of the accepted recommendations needed to improve efficiency, consistency, and reliable service delivery for residential solid waste and recycling services, for a period not to exceed two years. All other terms and conditions contained in the contract shall remain the same.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the costs of the contract amendment shall not exceed \$94,600 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-7013-6320, RQS 7013, RLA 2019-55.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
