WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 115-2, the 4-year term of a Council-appointed seat expired August 16, 2021; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 115-2, Council has requested and reviewed applications to fill the expired term and has selected from the applicants a member to the Board whose term began August 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety, in that Council must fill the seat of the expired term on the Civilian Police Review Board so that it complies with the Charter, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1</u>. That this Council hereby appoints the following individual to the Civilian Police Review Board:

AppointeeTermTeri WangAugust 17, 2021-August 16, 2025

<u>Section 2</u>. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
