AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 723-2020, passed September 9, 2020, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into an agreement with the Graffiti Heart Corporation for the Euclid - Green Mural Project through the use of Ward 10 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 723-2020, passed September 9, 2020, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$3,500 \$5,200 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 723-2020, passed September 9, 2020, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
