Ord. No. 534-2021

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

To amend Section 535.051 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1240-12, passed September 10, 2012, relating to testing and monitoring programs and water bill credits.

Ord. No. 653-2021

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

To amend Ordinance No. 1368-15, passed December 7, 2015, by adding two new whereas clauses and Sections 2 and 2a; to amend Section 1; to amend and renumber Section 2 to Section 1a; relating to the public improvement of constructing the Boosted Third High System in Richfield, Ohio and related site improvements.

Ord. No. 656-2021

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more requirement contracts without competitive bidding with Southeastern Equipment Co. Inc., Ohio Machinery Co. dba Ohio CAT, and Murphy Tractor & Equipment Co., Inc. for the purchase of proprietary replacement parts of heavy-duty construction equipment, and labor and materials to repair and maintain the proprietary equipment, for the Divisions of Water, Water Pollution Control, and Cleveland Public Power, Department of Public Utilities, for a term of two years.

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Ord. No. 763-2021

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with Windstream Holdings II, LLC dba Kinetic Business by Windstream for telecommunication service lines for primary and backup communications for SCADA control, security cameras, and telephones at various locations which are outside of Cuyahoga County and beyond the AT&T service area; and to authorize payment of monthly charges to Windstream, for a period up to three years, for the Division of Water, Department of Public Utilities. Estimated Cost: \$75,000

Ord. No. 779-2021

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

Authorizing the general fund to receive and use revenue from tax remittances collected by Cleveland Public Power during the years 2022 and 2023 and transfer 100% of tax remittances collected in both years back to Cleveland Public Power.

Ord. No. 870-2021

By Council Members Kazy, Bishop and Kelley (by departmental request)

Authorizing the purchase by one or more requirement contracts of labor and materials necessary for analysis, identification, storage, remediation, transportation, clean-up, emergency response, recycling, and disposal of various chemicals, hazardous waste products, and other non-hazardous and recyclable waste materials, routine industrial cleaning, and required training, for the Divisions of Water, Cleveland Public Power, and Water Pollution Control, Department of Public Utilities and the Department of Public Works for a period of two years, with two one-year options to renew, the first of which shall require additional legislative authority.
