2019-2020 Grinding of Pavement

DIVISION: Streets

ORDINANCE NO: 943-2021

DESCRIPTION: This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Works to enter into a Public Improvement Requirement contract for the grinding of pavement for local resurfacing of City streets.

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: This legislation is necessary for the 2021-2022 grinding season and to ensure the safety of public traveling on City streets.

CONTRACT TERMS: One (1) year with two (2) additional one-year renewal options at the discretion of the Director of Public Works.

- Estimated \$1,104,000.00

CURRENT CONTRACT: Contract No. CT-7016-PIRC-2019-001
Up to eighteen months – 2019-2022 grinding season

- Estimated \$1,386,000.00

CONTRACT EXPIRES: June 19, 2022

FUNDING SOURCE: Operating Budget, Roads & Bridge Bonds, Restricted Income Tax, NEF Funds, and additional funding sources as deemed appropriate by the Director of Finance.
